

Northeast Eagles AAU Baseball Program Player-Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct Agreement 2025-2026

The purpose of this document is to ensure that both players and parents/guardians of players involved in the Northeast Eagles AAU Baseball Program (the "Program") are made aware of and have agreed to the Code of Conduct. Each player and parent/guardian is expected to sign, acknowledge and abide by the Code of Conduct. The Eagles organization seeks to build a strong positive culture of good sportsmanship and exemplary behavior. This Code applies to coaches, team managers, players, parents/guardians, and even family and friends of the Eagles and its players.

Because this is such an important aspect to the culture of the organization, we want to clearly specify the expectations and ensure everyone is fully informed so we can then hold all the individuals mentioned above accountable for their behavior.

Failure to observe the Code of Conduct could result in forfeiture of a player's game/tournament participation and/or continued team participation. Players who violate the Code of Conduct will be benched. Family members who violate the Code of Conduct may be asked to leave a game/tournament and/or the practice facility/gym premises. A player may be asked to leave the organization entirely for repeated violations of the Code, and if so, there will be no refunds of the player participation fees.

I, the undersigned, hereby pledge to the following:

Players:

- I will demonstrate good sportsmanship and respect toward my teammates, coaches, competitors and officials at every game and practice.
- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my team and others ahead of my personal desire to win or the need to excel individually.
- I will do my best to keep my body in shape and maintain a positive mental attitude for the duration of the season.
- I will follow the Program's attendance policy (i.e., prioritize my attendance at Northeast Eagles games ahead of my participation in any other baseball program I may be enrolled in, attend all NE/AUU playoff games my team is eligible for, arrive at each practice so I am ready to begin at the practice's start time, arrive at each game

- 60 minutes prior to the game's start time, ask my parents/guardians to provide the Program with at least 3 days advance notice if I am not able to attend a Northeast Eagles game (excluding NE/AAU playoff games where attendance is required).
- I will honor the game of baseball and be a good role model and an ambassador for the Northeast Eagles.

Parents/Guardians:

- I will support the coaches and team managers working with the Program in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable baseball experience for all.
- I will always behave respectfully toward my child's teammates, other players, coaches, fans and the officials, despite what they may do or how they themselves might behave and regardless of race, geography, creed or ability. I will also reinforce this perspective with my child and will role model the desired behavior for my child.
- I will do my very best to make the sport of baseball fun for my child and their teammates and help my child balance winning and personal achievement with teamwork and learning baseball skills and life lessons.
- I will communicate directly with coaches or team managers regarding any problems, questions, concerns, or improvement ideas involving my child, the team, or the Program in general.
- I will be responsible for picking up and dropping off my child to practices and games. In addition, I will ensure my child follows the Program's attendance policy (i.e., prioritize my child's attendance at Northeast Eagles games ahead of their participation in any other baseball program my child may be enrolled in, have my child attend all NE/AAU playoff games their team is eligible for, deliver my child to each practice attended so my child is ready to begin at the practice's start time, deliver my child to each game attended 60 minutes prior to the game's start time, provide the Program with at least 3 days advance notice if my child is not able to attend a Northeast Eagles game (excluding NE/AAU playoff games where attendance is required).
